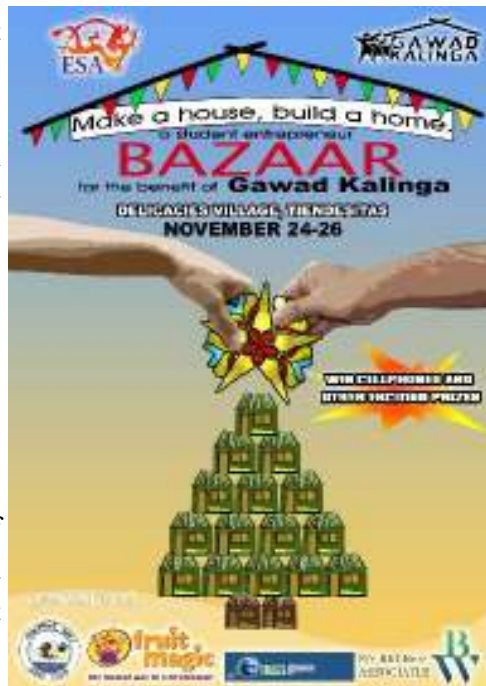


# Make a House, Build a Home
